The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual National Parliamentary Training Symposium will be hosted by **The Centre for Parliamentary Studies and Training (CPST).** This symposium seeks to provide an opportunity for Parliament, County Assemblies, County Executives, Ethics and Anti-corruption Commission (EACC) and other stake holders to share their experiences in combating corruption on the theme: 'The Role of Legislatures in the Fight against corruption.' #### **Submission Guidelines**

- The abstracts and/or posters not exceeding 300 words should be submitted online using the following link: <a href="mailto:centreforparliamentarystudies@gmail.com">centreforparliamentarystudies@gmail.com</a>
- Abstracts should clearly highlight the objective, problem, methodology, key findings/results, conclusions, recommendations and six key words. Also purely theoretical papers focusing on the subthemes will be accepted.
- Each abstract should include the name of the author(s), affiliation(s), postal address, e-mail, and Telephone Contacts. The length of the abstract should be 300 words.
- Each full paper should **Not Exceed 5,000 words** (excluding abstract, references and footnotes), Single Spacing Font Size 12, Times New Roman, Tables and Figures Inserted where first cited, Ms Word Format.
- The abstract and the full paper should follow the APA format of referencing.
- All references listed should be cited appropriately in the text.
