- The full paper should Not Exceed 5,000 words (excluding abstract, references and footnotes), single spacing, font size 12, Times New Roman, tables and figures inserted where first cited in Microsoft Word Format.
- The abstract and the full paper should follow the APA 6<sup>th</sup> edition format of referencing.
- · All references listed should be cited appropriately in the text.
