i) deleting sub-section 4(b) of the proposed new section 6A and inserting therefor the following new sub-section-

(b) research and promotion of the use of local raw materials for the manufacture of alcohol.

ii) deleting sub-section 4(c) of the proposed new section 6A.

Debate arising;

Raising a point of order, the Senate Majority Leader claimed to move that the Committee of the Whole report progress on its consideration of the Alcoholic Drinks Control (Amendment) Bill, (Senate Bill No. 5 of 2014) and seek leave to sit again tomorrow;
