4. <u>PETITION BY THREE RESIDENTS OF BUSIA COUNTY CONCERNING NON-</u> <u>PAYMENT OF DUES BY MADAM R. ENTERPRISES LIMITED AND THE</u> <u>COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF BUSIA.</u>

6. STATEMENTS PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 45 (2) (b)

The Chairperson of the Standing Committee on Education issued a Statement regarding the alleged leadership crisis at Moi University.

The Chairperson informed the House that there was no leadership crisis in Moi University. He stated that the situation at the university was a transitional phase as the University Council processes the replacement of the outgoing Vice- Chancellor, Prof. Richard K. Mibey, who had served for two terms hence ineligible for another term.

The Chairperson further informed the House that Prof. Laban Ayiro is the current Acting Vice Chancellor at Moi University with two substantively appointed Deputy Vice Chancellors namely Prof. Ogech and Prof. Kimengich. The Chairperson stated that the substantive Vice Chancellor shall be appointed by the Cabinet Secretary as soon as the University Council satisfies the provisions of the law, and the accompanying regulations in recruiting the next Vice Chancellor.
