Procedural Motion – Limitation of Debate on the Universities (Amendment) Bill, 2015

Rising on a point of order, the Member for Kesses (Hon. James Kimaru) claimed to move that, notwithstanding provisions of Standing Order 97(4) and the House resolution of February 10, 2016 regarding debate on Bills sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party, each speech in the debate on the Universities (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No.67 of 2015) be limited to a maximum of three (3) minutes for any Member speaking;

And the Deputy Speaker acceding to the claim;

Question put and agreed to.
