COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

MEDIATION COMMITTEE FOR THE PUBLIC AUDIT BILL, 2014

Honourable Members,

Following the rejection of the Senate's Amendments to Clauses 5, 11, 19, 24, 32 and 39 of the Public Audit Bill, 2014 by the House just moments ago, I wish to convey that this Bill now stands referred to a Mediation Committee as contemplated under Article 112 of the Constitution.

I have therefore appointed the **Honourables Benjamin Langat**, **MP**, **Makali Mulu**, **MP**, and **Johnson Sakaja**, **MP** to represent the National Assembly in the Mediation Committee. The Committee should confine itself to the six contested clauses of the Bill. Due to the constitutional deadlines of tomorrow, the 27th May, 2015, I request the Mediation Committee to meet in the course of tomorrow morning and submit their Report before 1.00pm. This will ensure that the two Houses consider the Mediated Version of the Bill within the constitutional timeline.
