6. STATEMENT PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 45(2) (B)

The Vice-Chairperson of the Standing Committee on Energy issued a statement regarding the compensation of land owners affected by the Kenya Electricity Transmission Company (KETRACO) in Samburu County.

Thereupon, the Vice-Chairperson informed the House that sixty seven (67) land owners in Samburu County were affected by the Loiyangalani-Suswa transmission line, and that KETRACO had allocated Kshs.193,506,001/= for compensation of the affected land owners. Of the said amount, Kshs.97,736,523/= had since been disbursed to twenty one (21) land owners.

The Vice-Chairperson also informed the House that a total of forty six (46) land owners were yet to be compensated for their land, out of whom nine (9) had completed the negotiation process, twenty (20) were undergoing the negotiation process, four (4) were missing requisite documentation or ownership of the affected land parcels was in dispute while the remaining thirteen (13) were absentee landlords, and an advertisement had been placed on the local dailies to facilitate their identification.

- (2) A person shall be qualified for appointment as the chairperson of the council under subsection (1)(a) or as a member of the council under subsection (1)(d) if the person
 - (a) holds a masters degree from a university recognized in Kenya;
 - (b) has—
 - (i) in the case of the chairperson of the council, ten years experience; and
 - (ii) in the case of a member of the council, five years experience;
 - in leadership, management or academia at a senior level; and
 - (c) is of high moral character and integrity and meets the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution and is capable of contributing to university education.

That, the New Clause 4A be now read a Second Time.
