- i) The Senator for Kakamega County (Sen. (Dr.) Boni Khalwale) sought a statement from the Senate Majority Leader regarding the forthcoming visit to Kenya by the President of the United States of America (USA).
- ii) The Chairperson of the Standing Committee on Land and Natural Resources issued a statement regarding the ongoing property development at the junction of Loresho Ridge Road and Kaptagat Road.

Thereupon, the Chairperson informed the Committee that the said parcel of land was public land reserved for a water reservoir but had erroneously been transferred to a private developer.

He stated that the Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development had formally requested the National Land Commission (NLC) to revoke the transfer and that NLC had initiated the revocation process. In the meantime, the Commission had issued a stop order to halt construction works on the said parcel of land and barred the developer from undertaking any works on the land.

The Chairperson assured the Senate that his Committee would follow up the matter to its logical conclusion.
