****THE PETITION TO COUNTY ASSEMBLIES (PROCEDURE) BILL**
(SENATE BILL NO. 35 OF 2014)

(Chairperson, Standing Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights)

NOTICE is given that the Chairperson, Standing Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, intends to move the following amendments to the Petition to County Assemblies (Procedure) Bill, 2014, at the Committee Stage-

CLAUSE 5

THAT clause 5 of the Bill be amended in sub-clause (3) by deleting the words "facilitate public participation" appearing immediately after the words "the county assembly shall" and substituting therefor the words "conduct public hearings".
