Following the Invitation to Tender for the above mentioned tender on **Tuesday**, **3**<sup>rd</sup> **October 2017** and having received request for clarification from interested firms, the National Assembly wishes to clarify as follows:-

- <u>Clause 2.1.4 on documentation and facilitation of the Consultant.</u> The National Assembly shall facilitate the Consultant to obtain or be provided with such documents as may be available to carry out the audit.
- 2) <u>Clause 2.3.3 on duration of the assignment</u> The period of the assignment is three (3) years.
- 3) Clause 2.3.4 on Conflict of interest

The Consultant should not have undertaken any assignment on behalf of the Office of the Auditor General for the period 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017. In addition, the Consultant shall not undertake any assignment on behalf of Office of the Auditor General during the subsistence of this contract.

This is to prevent any conflict of interest in case where the successful firm is expected to give an unbiased/ fair opinion in an assignment/contract they have been party to or assignments they have already reviewed.

- Expected timings of the audits The timing of the audit shall be agreed between the successful firm and the Contract Administrator.
- 5) Page 62: Tender security

A tender security of Kshs. 50,000.00 in the prescribed format to be issued in favour of the Parliamentary Service Commission (PSC).

6) <u>Level of expenditure</u>

All the expenditure of the office of the Auditor General for each of the three (3) years.
