Before we proceed with this Order, I want to guide the House as follows-

Hon. Members,

We are now using the Supplementary Order Paper in Circulation. Order No. 8 on the said Order Paper is Motion to adopt the First Report of the Committee on Appointments on the Vetting of Cabinet Nominees. The Motion also seeks to request the House to **approve** the nomination of certain persons and **reject** the nomination of another.

Hon. Members,

When the Motion is Moved and Seconded, I will propose the Question of the entire Motion as contained in the Order Paper. This will open debate to Members to speak to the Motion. At this point, any Member who may want to amend the Report may do so by moving a motion to amend the Motion, together with the Report. At this point, I will remind any Member with an amendment to approach the Table during the time of moving the Motion for the Clerk to draft such proposed amendment appropriately. However, each amendment will have to be approved by the Speaker pursuant to our Standing Orders.

However, **Hon. Members**, amendment to delete any name will not be allowed at this point, since the Speaker will thereafter put severally, the question for approval of EACH proposed nominee at the conclusion of the debate. Therefore, a Member intending to oppose the nomination of any nominee, other than those propose to be rejected in the text of the Motion will have to wait for the Question to be put against the specific nominee. I will dispose of with any amendment to the motion and, if carried, propose the question of the Motion in amended form.

Hon. Members,

Thereafter, I will put the Question for approval of EACH proposed nominee for the decision of the House, in the order that their appear in the Motion.
