**(i) Passage of and Assent to the County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bill No. 11 of 2018)**

“Honourable Senators,

I have a brief Communication to make, regarding the County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bills No. 11 of 2018).

1. The County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bills No. 11 of 2018 which was published in the Kenya *Gazette* Supplement No. 39 of 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 was passed, with amendments, by the Senate on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 and subsequently referred to the National Assembly. The Bill was read a First time in the National Assembly on 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 and passed without amendments on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2018.
2. Honourable Senators, pursuant to Article 110(5) of the Constitution and Standing Order 157(1), when a Bill originating in the Senate is passed by the National Assembly, without amendments, the Speaker of the Senate is required to certify and refer the Bill to the President for assent within seven days of the passage of the Bill by the National Assembly.
3. Honourable Senators, in accordance with the above provisions, I certified and referred County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bills No. 11 of 2018) to the President and would now like to report to the Senate that, His Excellency the President assented to the Bill on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> June, 2018.
