7. STATEMENTS PURSUANT TO STANDING 44(2)(b)

Pursuant to Standing Order 44(2)(b), the following Statements were issued –

- (i) by the Chairperson, Departmental Committee on Transport, Public Works and Housing regarding the status of offices occupied by Government ministries in response to a request by the Member for Kipkelion East (Hon. Joseph Limo);

The Chairperson informed the House that the Government owns 16 buildings and has leased 276 buildings in all the 47 counties. As to whether the Government has put in place measures to ensure that public funds are used efficiently in purchasing or leasing houses, before any leasing is done the need for it is ascertained and after confirming there is no space available in a Government building.

- (ii) by the Chairperson, Departmental Committee on Transport, Public Works and Housing regarding the status of Kakamega-Kaburengu road, in response to a request by the Member for Malava (Hon. Malulu Injendi);

The Chairperson informed the House that the project includes the reconstruction and widening of the existing road and also the construction of a second carriageway from Kakamega for a distance of five kilometers to form a dual carriageway. The project portion implemented to date is only 1.23 per cent and includes deviations, site clearance, removal of top soil and stripping and other works for widening.
