Notice is given that the Member for Homa Bay Town (Hon. Peter Kaluma), intends to move the following amendments to the Report of the Public Accounts Committee on the Special Audit report of May 2016 on the accounts of the National Youth Service (NYS):-

THAT, the Motion be amended by inserting the following words immediately after the word "2017"-

"subject to -

- (i) deletion of the words "if found guilty after due process" appearing after the words "holding public office" in Recommendation 4 on page 176 of the Report; and
- (ii) addition of the following new Recommendation 31 on page 185 of the Report:
 - "31. Parliament proceeds to immediately review and subsequently repeal the National Youth Service Act, 1964."

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The House resolved on Wednesday, January 25, 2017 as follows:-

- THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 97(4), each speech in a debate on Bills sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of forty five (45) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each (if the Bill is not sponsored by either of them); and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Departmental Committee, in that order.
- THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 97(4), this House orders that, each speech in a debate on a **Report of a Committee**, including a Report of a Joint Committee of the Houses of Parliament or any other Report submitted to the House, be limited as follows: -A maximum of sixty (60) minutes for the Mover in moving and thirty (30) minutes in replying, and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that order.
