THAT, aware that following the 2007 post-election violence, various state and non-state agencies carried out independent investigations, either on their own motion or in the exercise of their statutory functions; Further aware that, some of those agencies, including the Commission appointed by the then President to inquire into the matters pertaining to the Post Election Violence (the Waki Commission), either submitted or publicized their findings and/or reports, which are yet to be discussed by the National Assembly; Cognizant of the fact that the matter of possible compromise and allegations of skewed investigations has been of concern to the People of Kenya, including allegations that some of the witnesses who testified before the Commission and other agencies may have been procured; Recalling that Article 95 of the Constitution provides that the National Assembly deliberates on and resolves issues of concern to the people; Further recalling that, in 2010, Parliament amended the Commission of Inquiry Act (CAP. 102) to accord the National Assembly an opportunity to receive and discuss such findings or reports; this House -

- (a) resolves to establish a select Committee to inquire into and report on the allegations of the skewed and compromised investigations by the various state and non-state agencies on the matter of the 2007-Post Election Violence;
- (b) also resolves that the Committee elects its chairperson and vice-chairperson from amongst its Members;
- (c) further resolves that the Committee submits its report to the House within ninety (90) days, to inform the debate on the subsequent motion for noting the contents of the Report of the Commission of Inquiry into the Post Election Violence(CIPEV) which was tabled in the House on 4th December 2008; and,
- (d) approves the appointment of the following Members to the Committee:-
