## 6. NOTICE OF MOTION - ADJOURNMENT OF THE SENATE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF STANDING ORDER 34 (1) TO DISCUSS A DEFINITE MATTER OF URGENT NATIONAL IMPORTANCE

Raising a point of order, the Senator for Bomet County (Sen. (Dr.) Christopher Lang'at, MP) sought leave to move a Motion for the adjournment of the Senate to discuss a definite matter of urgent national importance, namely the disaster in West Pokot County occasioned by a landslide that claimed over fifty (50) persons following days of heavy rains in the County.

And there being the requisite number of Senators rising in support of the claim;

Thereupon, the Deputy Speaker directed that the Motion be moved at 5.00pm on the same day.

The Nominated Senator (Sen. (Arch.) Slyvia Kasanga, MP) made a Statement on behalf of Nominated Senator (Sen. (Dr.) Getrude Musuruve, MP) regarding the appointment of Sen. (Prof.) Margaret Kamar, MP as a Trustee of the National Fund for the Disabled of Kenya.

The Senator informed the House that via Gazette Notice No. 10746 of 4<sup>th</sup> November, 2019, the President appointed Sen. (Prof.) Kamar, Ms. Cecilia Mbaka and Ms. Anne Mugambi as a Trustees of the Fund National Fund for the Disabled of Kenya.

The Senator further informed the House that through scholarly and legislative deliberations in the Standing Committee on Education, Sen. (Prof.) Kamar had assisted her in the completion of resource documents for persons living with disability (PWDs) that were approved by the Kenya Institute for Curriculum Development. These include -

- i. Signing Made Easy, Learners Book 1
- ii. Signing Made Easy, Teachers Guide
- iii. An Anthology, I speak for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing

The Senator expressed her confidence in Sen. (Prof.) Kamar to work with her and other colleagues in identifying genuine PWDs across the 47 counties and ensuring that there was fair and impartial financial support for all PWD groups.

The Senator congratulated Sen. (Prof.) Kamar, on her appointment and indicated that it was her hope and belief that Sen. (Prof.) Kamar's appointment was a triumph for PWDs in Kenya.
