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# **NOTICES**

## **I. MOTION ON INQUIRY INTO THE OPTIMIZATION OF REVENUE IN GRAIN HANDLING SERVICES AT THE PORT OF MOMBASA**

Notice is given that the Member for Makueni (Hon. Daniel Maanzo) intends to move the following amendments to the Motion on the Report of the Departmental Committee on Finance and National Planning on the Inquiry into the Optimization of Revenue in Grain Handling Services at the Port of Mombasa-

**THAT**, the Motion be amended by inserting the following words after the figure “2020” –

“Subject to insertion of the following new recommendations 80 and 81 on page 17 of the Report:

80. That, the Kenya Ports Authority urgently formulates, and implements a variation of the license agreement with Grain Bulk Handling Limited to ensure value for money, public accountability and strict adherence to ethical, competitive and fair business practices;
81. That, notwithstanding the recommendations under paragraph 80, the Kenya Ports Authority institutes a comprehensive audit of Grain Bulk Handling Limited taking into account past resolutions by Parliament and other government agencies.”

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The House resolved on Wednesday, February 10, 2021 as follows-

### **Limitation of Debate on Individual Members’ Bills**

- II. THAT**, each speech in a debate on **Bills NOT** sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party shall be limited as follows:- A maximum of three hours and thirty minutes, with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover, in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each; and that priority in speaking shall be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Departmental Committee, in that order.

Limitation of Debate on Committee Reports

- III. THAT**, each speech in a debate on **Committee Reports (except for Reports of Audit Committees)**, including a Report of a Joint Committee of the Houses of Parliament or any other Report submitted to the House for which limitation of time has not been specified, shall be limited as follows:- A maximum of two and a half hours, with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover in moving and five (5) minutes for any other Member speaking, **including** the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Committee Report is not moved by the Chairperson of the relevant Committee), and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and further that priority in speaking shall be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that order.

Limitation of Debate on Bills sponsored by Parties or Committees

- IV. THAT**, each speech in a debate on **Bills sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party** shall be limited as follows:- A maximum of forty five (45) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each (if the Bill is not sponsored by either of them); and that priority in speaking shall be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Departmental Committee, in that order.
