MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE

(No. 1 of 2022)

PASSAGE BY THE SENATE OF THE POLITICAL PARTIES (AMENDMENT)
BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY NO. 56 OF 2021)

Honourable Members,

As you are aware, Standing Order 41(4) of the National Assembly Standing Orders requires the Speaker to report to the House any Message received from the Senate as soon as the House next sits. In this regard, I wish to report that in the evening of 26th, January 2022, I did receive a Message from the Senate regarding its passage of the Political Parties (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No.56 of 2021). You may recall that the Bill was considered and passed by the National Assembly on 5th January 2022.

Honourable Members, in summary, the Message conveys that the Senate **passed** the Bill in the form passed by the National Assembly. This action concluded the bicameral processing of the Political Parties (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No.56 of 2021). Subsequently, in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(5) of the Constitution, I presented the Bill to H.E the President for Assent on 27th January, 2022. H.E The President Assented to the Bill on the same day. The House is thus accordingly informed.
