Nominated Senator (Sen. Getrude Musuruve) made a Statement regarding an issue of general topical concern, namely; the "World Radio Day".

Thereupon, the Senator informed the Senate that the day was proclaimed by the Member States of UNESCO in the year 2011 and was, subsequently, adopted by the United Nations General Assembly as an International Day in 2012 and February 13 became the World Radio Day (WRD).

The Senator also informed the Senate that the theme for World Radio Day 2022 was '*Radio and Trust*', which had been divided into three sub-themes namely: Trust Radio Journalism, Trust and Accessibility and Trust and Viability of radio stations.

The Senator observed that radio has unique ability to reach the widest audience signifying that local radio stations play a very significant role in ensuring that local communities access information, while noting that vernacular radio stations have been critical in disseminating information on climate, which has helped the citizenry make informed decisions about climate change interventions.

The Senator urged the national and county governments to support community radio stations, as they are a source of information.
