In this regard, **Honourable Members**, during the recess period, I did notify all Members of receipt of the names and refer the same to the Departmental Committee on Defence and Foreign Relations in accordance with the provision of Standing Order No.45(1) (Committal of Messages to Committees).

The Committee is required to commence necessary vetting processes as contemplated under the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act and Standing Order 45 (*Committal of public appointments to Committees*) and thereafter table its report for consideration by the House within the statutory timelines.
