**MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE**

*(No. 5 of 2020)*

**APPOINTMENT OF SENATORS TO THE MEDIATION COMMITTEE TO CONSIDER THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL (SENATE BILLS NO. 30 OF 2020)**

**Honourable Members**, you will recall that on Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2022, the National Assembly **rejected** the Wildlife Conservation and Management (Amendment) Bill (Senate Bill No. 30 of 2020). Pursuant to the provisions of Article 112 of the Constitution and Standing Order 149 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, the Bill was committed to a Mediation Committee.

Subsequently, I appointed the following five Members to represent the National Assembly in the Mediation Committee and conveyed the decision of the National Assembly to the Senate:

2. The Hon. Paul Nzengu, MP;
3. The Hon. Ali Amin Deddy, MP;
4. The Hon. Rozaah Akinyi Buyu, MP; and
5. The Hon. Bernard Shinali, MP.

**Honourable Members,** pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41, I wish to report to the House that I am in receipt of a correspondence from the Senate, dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2022, conveying that the Senate has appointed the following Senators to the Mediation Committee to consider the said Bill:
