NOTIFICATION FROM THE SPEAKER
[Standing Order 41(5)]

ON
THE PASSAGE OF SIX NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILLS BY THE
SENATE

WHEREAS *the Sustainable Waste Management Bill, 2021 (National Assembly Bill No. 22 of 2021), the Irrigation (Amendment) Bill, 2021 (National Assembly Bill No. 12 of 2021), the Public Procurement & Asset Disposal (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 32 of 2021), the Sacco Societies (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 55 of 2021), the Children Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 38 of 2021) and the Community Groups Registration Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 20 of 2021)* were published on various dates **as Bills concerning county governments;**

WHEREAS the National Assembly considered and passed the said Bills on diverse dates and referred them to the Senate for consideration in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(4) of the Constitution;

FURTHER WHEREAS, I have now received a Message from the Speaker of the Senate conveying that, on 16th June, 2022, the Senate considered and **PASSED** the said six (6) Bills **without amendments;**

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provision of Standing Order 41(5) and the Resolution of the House of 2nd February, 2022 regarding Messages received by the Speaker when the House is on recess -

IT IS NOTIFIED to all Members of the National Assembly and the general public –

- 1. THAT**, the bicameral passage of the six (6) Bills originating from the National Assembly has been **concluded**; and,
- 2. THAT**, in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(5) of the Constitution, I will present the six (6) Bills to the President for **Assent** within the statutory time-lines.
