## 1 PREFACE

## 1.1 ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMITTEE

- 2. The power of each House of Parliament to establish Committees and to make Standing Orders for the orderly conduct of its proceedings, including the proceedings of its Committees is provided under Article 124 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.
- 3. The National Assembly Standing Orders has established various Committees of the House with distinct Mandates. These Committees under the Directorate of Departmental Committees play a pivotal role of facilitating the National Assembly fulfill its constitutional mandate of investigating, inquire into, and reporting on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned Ministries and departments.

## 1.2 MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE

- 4. The Departmental Committee on Transport, Public Works and Housing is established under Standing Order 216(1) whose mandate, pursuant to the Standing Order 216 (5), is as follows;
  - a. investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned Ministries and departments;
  - b. study the programme and policy objectives of Ministries and departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
  - c. study and review all legislation referred to it;
  - d. study, assess and analyze the relative success of the Ministries and departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
  - e. investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned Ministries and departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the House;
  - f. to vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the National Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 204 (Committee on Appointments);
  - f. examine treaties, agreements and conventions;
  - g. make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation;
  - h. make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation;
  - i. consider reports of Commissions and Independent Offices submitted to the House pursuant to the provisions of Article 254 of the Constitution; and
  - j. examine any questions raised by Members on a matter within its mandat?.
- 5. Further, the Second Schedule to the Standing Orders mandates the Committee to consider matters relating to the following subjects:
  - a) Transport;
  - b) Roads;
  - c) Public works;
  - d) Construction and maintenance of roads, rails and buildings;
  - e) Air and seaports; and
  - f) Housing.

- 6. In executing this mandate, the Committee oversights various State Departments, namely:
  - a) The State Department of Transport;
  - b) The State Department of Infrastructure;
  - c) The State Department of Housing and Urban Development;
  - d) The State Department of Public Works; and
  - e) The State Department of Shipping and Maritime Affairs.

#### 3.2 COMMITTEE ACHIEVEMENTS

- a. The Committee facilitated the legal and legislative mechanism for tolling that enabled the construction of the first expressway in the country, a mega infrastructural project. This has opened the way for more projects which will be done through the same model.
- b. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the Standard Gauge Railway, with a view to ensure a win-win outcome between the government on one hand and the citizen and businesspersons on the other hand.
- c. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the aviation sector, with recommendations that led to the introduction of a government Bill on the National Aviation Management.
- d. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the alarming cases of traffic accidents in the country. This led to the restructuring of the functions of agencies that led to the removal of the NTSA officers from the road.
- e. The Committee, while facilitating responses to Members' Questions and Statements, managed to push for numerous infrastructural projects. This varied from roads projects countrywide, commuter rail improvements, enhancement of port operations, building of bridges and footbridges, construction, expansion and rehabilitation of airports and airstrips, among others.
- f. Passage of key legislations including Bills and Petitions in the National Assembly that were key to ensuring that progressive and sustainable development was achieved in the infrastructural and housing spheres.
- g. The Committee Supported the State Department of Housing and Urban Development's initiative in
  - i) the provision of affordable Housing programme by prioritizing Social housing, mobilizing funds through National Housing Development Fund and fostering Public Private Partnership to fund 500,000 units.
  - ii) Decongestion of road traffic through Diesel Multiple Units (DMUs) and modernization of the Central Railway Station in Nairobi.
- h. The Committee supported the Ministry's request to fund projects during budgetary reviews. The process budget review aims at fast tracking development of critical infrastructure in the country and to implement this major policy goal of the government which in the end led to;
  - i) Expansion of the road network;
  - ii) Expansion of the rail network through rehabilitation of Metre Gauge Rail (MGR);
  - iii) Repairing, expansion and modernization of aviation facilities to maintain the country's competitive edge in the region; and
  - iv) Development of Ship Construction and repair yard in Kisumu as well as equipping Bandari Maritime Academy to effectively train seafarers;

## PART FOUR

## 4 REASONS WHY THE COMMITTEE DIDN'T CONCLUDE SOME OF ITS WORK

- 29. The Committee experienced the following challenges which made it difficult for it to optimally discharge its mandate:
  - I. Inadequate committee meeting rooms and furniture occasionally led to delays in starting meetings and at times cancellation of meetings.
- II. The COVID-19 pandemic affected the frequency of meetings and it made it difficult to meet stakeholders to prosecute matters before the Committee. This affected the Committee's efficiency in the execution of its mandate.
- III. The Court Ruling on the Petition by the Senate regarding consideration of Bills between the two Houses of Parliament halted consideration of Bills in the National Assembly for a while. This increased the backlog of Bills in the Committee.
- IV. Unavailability of Government officials when invited for meetings to consider business before the Committee. This made it difficult for the Committee to discharge its mandate effectively.
- V. Some Members whose business was referred to the Committee were not available when invited for Committee meetings to consider their Questions, Legislative Proposals, Statements or Petitions.

VI. Difficulty in raising quorum because of the 2022 General Elections, especially in Sixth Session slowed down activities of the Committee.

## MIN No. TPWH 180/2022: PRELIMINARIES

The Chairperson called the meeting to order at ten o'clock followed by a word of prayer. The Chairman informed the Honorable Members that the Committee was meeting stakeholders to consider the Report on the Kenya Roads Board (Amendment) Bill, 2022 and the Committee's Exit Report for the 12<sup>th</sup> Parliament.

The agenda of the meeting was therefore adopted after being proposed by the Hon. Tom Odege, MP and seconded by the Hon. Ali Wario, MP.

## MIN No. TPWH 181/2022: CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS SITTINGS

Minutes of the 33<sup>rd</sup> sitting which was held on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2022 were confirmed as a true record of the proceedings, after having been proposed by the Hon. Dominic Koskei, MP, and seconded by Hon. Tom Odege, MP.

## MIN NO. TPWH 182/2022:

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF THE REPORT ON THE KENYA ROADS BOARD (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2022 (NA BILLS NO. 13)

The Committee noted that the following stakeholders submitted written memoranda to the Committee, in response to the said call through the advertisements of 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2022:

- a) The State Department of Infrastructure;
- b) The Institution of Engineers of Kenya; and
- c) Mr. David Muriuki Kageenu.

The Committee further noted that it also met and discussed the Bill with stakeholders on Tuesday, 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2022, within Parliament Buildings.

The Committee noted that one Mr. David Muriuki Kageenu opposed the Bill to the extent that it proposes to allocate fifty per cent of the funds managed by the Kenya Roads Board to borrowing functions. He noted that whatever the Government intends to do can be done with the finances that they are already collecting and that there is need to practice sustainable infrastructure development. The Committee noted that the proposed use of a portion of already collected funds as collateral for borrowing shall ensure that the debt is sustainably managed.

## The Committee therefore **observed** that:

- (a) There is need to reconstitute the Membership of the Kenya Roads Board to enhance its corporate governance in line with the principles contained in the *Mwongozo* Code; and
- (b) The taxation of interest income earned by the Kenya Roads Board, Kenya National Highways Authority, Kenya Urban Roads Authority and the Kenya Rural Roads Authority reduces the capability of the agencies from fully executing their mandate. It would be more beneficial for the country if such income was exempted from taxation on condition that it is wholly used in the exercise of the respective mandates of the roads' agencies.

The Committee having considered the Kenya Roads Board Amendment Bill, 2022 (National Assembly Bill No. 13 of 2022), stakeholders' comments on the Bill and the above observations, **recommended** to the House that the Bill be approved with amendments to clause 3 and clause 4 of the Bill.

The report was adopted by the Committee, having been proposed by Hon. Shadrack Mose, MP, and seconded by Hon. Mercy Gakuya, MP.

## MIN NO. TPWH 183/2022:

# CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF THE COMMITTEE'S EXIT REPORT FOR THE 12<sup>TH</sup> PARLIAMENT

The Committee went through the draft Exit Report for the Committee's term during the 12<sup>th</sup> Parliament (from 2017 to 2022). The Committee adopted the report, confirming the true record of the activities as undertaken by the Committee.

Proposal for adoption of the Committee's Exit Report was made by Hon. Tom Odege and seconded by Hon. Samuel Arama.

Vide an invitation from the NTSA to the Committee, it was noted that the conference was scheduled for 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2022 in Mombasa. It was therefore proposed that the Committee Chairperson, four Committee Members, the Committee Clerks and the Legal Counsel attend the conference.
