NOTIFICATION TO ALL MEMBERS-ELECT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY: QUALIFIED CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION AS SPEAKER AND DEPUTY SPEAKER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

1. Standing Order 5(5) of the National Assembly Standing Orders, provides that:

“ 5 (5) Immediately upon close of the nomination period provided for in paragraph (2), the Clerk shall-

- (a) publicize and make available to all Members, a list showing all qualified candidates ;and*
- (b) make available to all Members, copies of the curriculum vitae of the qualified candidates.*

2.This is to notify all Members-Elect of the National Assembly that pursuant to Standing Order 5(5)(a), the following candidates qualify in terms of Article 106(1) (a) of the Constitution and Standing Orders 5 to contest for election to the office of the Speaker of the National Assembly:

(i) Moses Masika Wetangula; and

(ii) Kenneth Otiato Marende.

3. Additionally, pursuant to Article 106 (1) (b) of the Constitution and Standing Order 13, the following candidates qualify to contest for election to the office of the Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly:

(i) Farah Maalim;

(ii) Gladys Jepkosgei Boss; and

(iii) George Peter Opondo Kaluma.

4. Further, in accordance with Standing Order 5(4), the Clerk is in the process of ascertaining the documentation presented by the following candidates for election to the position of the office of the Speaker of the National Assembly:

(i) Thangeta Fredrick Mukaria; and

(ii) Mathew Erick Deya Okongo.

5. Finally, Standing Order 5(5)(b) of the National Assembly Standing Orders requires the Clerk to make available to all Members copies of the curriculum vitae of the qualified candidates. To this end, this is to inform all Members-Elect that copies of the curriculum vitae presented by the candidates listed in paragraphs 2 and 3 herein have been circulated.
