SUBJECT: NOMINATION MEMBERS OF ALLOCATION					

WHEREAS, the term of office of the current members of the Commission on Revenue Allocation (CRA) is set to terminate on $31^{\rm st}$ December, 2022 in accordance with the provisions of Article 250(6)(a) of the Constitution;

NOTING, Article 215(2)(b) and (c) as read with Article 215(3) of the Constitution requires political parties represented in the National Assembly and the Senate to nominate two (2) and five (5) persons respectively, for appointment as members of the Commission on Revenue Allocation from among persons who are not Members of Parliament;

FURTHER WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 215(2)(b) and (c) of the Constitution as read with section 5(1) of the *Commission on Revenue Allocation Act, 2011*, the Clerks of the Houses of Parliament, by advertisements published in the print media on 15th November, 2022, invited applications from interested persons seeking to be nominated as members of the Commission and set out the qualifications for appointment in accordance with Article 215(4) of the Constitution as read with section 6 of *the Commission on Revenue Allocation Act, 2011*.

AND WHEREAS, at the closure of the submission period, the Clerks of the Houses of Parliament forwarded the particulars of qualified applicants to the Leaders of the Majority and Minority Parties in Parliament to facilitate nomination of persons for appointment;

IT IS NOTIFIED to all Members of the National Assembly that, on Friday, 25th November, 2022 and Saturday, 26th November, 2022, I received communication from the Leadership of the Majority and Minority Parties conveying the selection of seven (7) persons for appointment to the membership of the Commission on Revenue Allocation in accordance with Article 215(2)(b) and (c) of the Constitution as listed hereunder –

NOW THEREFORE, in order to facilitate the approval process as required under Article 250(2)(b) of the Constitution—

- (a) the names stand referred to the Departmental Committee on Finance & National Planning to commence the necessary vetting processes as contemplated under the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 and Standing Order 45 (Committal of public appointments to Committees);
- (b) upon assembly of the House on Tuesday, 29th November 2022, I shall convey the names of the afore-listed nominees to the assembled House; and
- (c) the Clerk of the National Assembly is hereby required –

- (i) to transmit this Notification to all Members of the National Assembly; and
- (ii) pursuant to section 6 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011, to notify the public of the place and time of the approval hearings and invite the members of the public to submit any representations they may have, by way of written statements on oath contesting the suitability of any of the nominees to hold office under Article 215(2)(b) and (c) of the Constitution.
