MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

NOMINATION OF PERSONS FOR APPOINTMENT AS PRINCIPAL SECRETARIES

Honourable Members,

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 42, I wish to convey a Message from His Excellency the President regarding nomination of persons for appointment as Principal Secretaries.

2. In the Message, **Honourable Members**, His Excellency the President conveys that, in exercise of powers conferred on him by Article 132(2)(d) of the Constitution, as read together with sections 3 & 5 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011, he nominates the following persons for appointment as Principal Secretaries —

S/No.	Nominee	State Department / Ministry
1.	Ms. Salome Wairimu Muhia-Beacco	State Department for Correctional Services, Ministry of Interior & National Administration.
2.	Ms. Anne Njoki Wang'ombe	State Department for Performance Management & Delivery Services, Office of the Prime Cabinet Secretary

3. Honourable Members, Article 132(2)(d) of the Constitution provides that—

"The President shall nominate and, with the approval of the National Assembly, appoint, and may dismiss Principal Secretaries....";

4. In this regard, Honourable Members, His Excellency the President now seeks the approval of the said persons by the National Assembly.

5. Honourable Members, Standing Order 45(1) requires that upon receipt of notification of nomination for appointments, such nominations shall stand committed to the relevant Departmental Committees for consideration.

6. In this regard and pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 45 and paragraph (3) of Standing Order 42 (Messages from the President),

I hereby refer the Message from H.E. the President, together with the certificate of Presidential nominations, the *Curriculum Vitae* and other testimonials of the nominees to the respective Departmental Committees as follows—

S/No	Nominee	Departmental Committee
1.	Ms. Salome Wairimu Muhia – Beacco	Justice and Legal Affairs
2.	Ms. Anne Njoki Wang'ombe	Administration and Internal Security

7. Honourable Members, section 8 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 requires the National Assembly to consider such nominations within twenty-eight (28) days.

8. In this regard, the Committees are expected to immediately commence the approval processes and notify the nominees and the general public of the time and place for holding the approval hearings. Thereafter, upon conclusion of the said hearings, table their respective reports on or before **Wednesday, 28th June 2023** to enable the House consider the matter within the prescribed statutory timelines.
