(On the occasion of the Address to Parliament by His Excellency the President of the Republic of Kenya pursuant to Article 132(1) (b) & (c) of the Constitution on 9th November 2023 in the National Assembly, Main Chamber at 2:30 pm)

1. Your Excellency, Hon. (Dr.) William S. Ruto, CGH, President of the Republic of Kenya and Commander-in-Chief of the Kenya Defence Forces;

The Rt. Hon. Amason Kingi, EGH, MP, Honourable Speaker of the Senate;

Honourable Members of Parliament;

Members of the Diplomatic Corps;

Distinguished Guests; Ladies and Gentlemen;

2. Article 132(1)(b) of the Constitution of Kenya requires the President to address the nation once every year and at any other time. Further, Article 132(1)(c) requires the President to once every year, report, in an address to the nation, on measures taken and progress achieved in the realization of our national values.

- **3.** Additionally, Article 132(1)(c)(iii) of the Constitution provides that the President shall submit a report for debate to the National Assembly on the progress made in fulfilling the international obligations of the Republic.
- 4. In this regard, Hon. Members, by way of a Message to the House dated 26th September 2023, H.E. the President conveyed his desire to address a Joint Sitting of the Houses of Parliament today, 9th November 2023. Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 22 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, by *Gazette Notice* No. 14715, which was published in the *Kenya Gazette* on 3rd November 2023, I gave Notice of this Special Sitting of Parliament to the Members of the National Assembly.

Accordingly, Honourable Members, this Special Sitting is properly convened.

- **5. Your Excellency,** it is the custom of Parliament to recognize invited guests seated in our galleries. I therefore wish to recognize the following guests who are seated in the Speaker's Row:

- 9. Your Excellency, May I also accord special recognition to all Cabinet Secretaries present, Mr. Felix Koskei, Chief of Staff and Head of the Public Service, Principal Secretaries, members of the diplomatic corps, and Heads of Constitutional Commissions and Independent Offices present.

10. Your Excellency, I wish to make a special mention of the Chief of the Kenya Defence Forces, General Francis O. Ogolla and the respective service commanders, the Inspector General of Police and other leaders of our disciplined forces who are seated at the Speaker's Row.
