## NOTIFICATION OF AND INVITATION TO PUBLIC HEARING

**WHEREAS**, Article 118(1) (b) of the Constitution requires Parliament to facilitate public participation and involvement in the legislative and other business of Parliament and its Committees and Standing Order 127(3) of the National Assembly Standing Orders requires House Committees considering Bills to facilitate public participation;

**AND WHEREAS**, the **Privatisation Bill, (National Assembly Bill No. 36 of 2025)** was read a First Time and committed to the **Departmental Committee on Finance and National Planning** and the **Select Committee on Public Debt and Privatization** for consideration and reporting back to the House;

**IT IS NOTIFIED** that in addition to **receipt of written memoranda, engaging relevant stakeholders and consulting experts**, the **Departmental Committee on Finance and National Planning** and the **Select Committee on Public Debt Privatization** have resolved to hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** on the Bill at the **Kenyatta International Conference Center (KICC), Nairobi County on Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 from 9.00 a.m.** The Committees shall discuss the contents of the Bill and its implications during the Public Hearing. Members of the public are invited to attend and share their views on the Bill during on the said date.
