4. **LACK OF QUORUM AT COMMENCEMENT**

5. **COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR**

The Honourable Deputy Speaker issued the following Communication—

Referral of the Public Service (Values and Principles) (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 46 of 2022) to a Mediation Committee

“Honourable Members, you will recall that on Wednesday, 19th November, 2025, the House considered and **rejected** Senate amendments to the **Public Service (Values and Principles) (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 46 of 2022)**. The decision of the House remitted the Bill to a mediation committee pursuant to Article 112(2)(b) of the Constitution.

Honourable Members, Article 113 of the Constitution requires that whenever a Bill is referred to a Mediation Committee, the Speakers of the Houses of Parliament shall each appoint an equal number of Members from both Houses to attempt to develop a version of the Bill for consideration.

In this regard, **Honourable Members**, I have directed the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party to nominate Members for appointment to the Mediation Committee to consider the said Bill. Once I receive the names of the nominated Members, I shall notify the House. The House is accordingly informed. I thank you!”
