Dr. Wilberforce Oundo, MP. <p><i>This Bill seeks to amend the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, Cap. 265B, by introducing mandatory professional certification of wealth declarations made by nominees for public office. The aim is to enhance integrity, transparency, and accountability in the vetting process by ensuring that asset declaration is verified by qualified professionals in line with constitutional provisions</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ii. 		<p><i>The principal object of this Bill is to amend the Victim Protection Act to align the definition of the term "victim" with the Constitution.</i></p> <p><i>The Constitutional and Human Rights Division of the High Court in its judgment in Petition No. E400 of 2021 declared that the current definition restricts the term to only natural persons which contravenes Article 260 of the Constitution. The amendment thus expounds the term persons to include company, association or other body of persons whether incorporated or unincorporated.</i></p> <p>iii. Public Participation Bill, 2025 (NA Bill No. 44 of 2025)</p> <p><i>The principal object of the Bill is to provide a framework for effective public participation. The Bill gives effect to the Constitutional principle of participation of the people enshrined in Articles 1, 10, 35,69, 118, 174, 184, 196, 201, and 232 of the Constitution. The Bill also provides guiding principles to be adhered to by institutions conducting public participation. The Bill further designates the responsible authorities for purposes of the development of specific guidelines for public participation in each public institution.</i></p>
