**REFERRAL OF SENATE AMENDMENTS TO THE DIVISION OF
REVENUE BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 2 OF 2026) TO A
COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS the House, by a resolution passed on 11th February 2026, **ordered** that, upon receipt of any Message relating to the Senate's Amendments to a Bill originating in the National Assembly, the Speaker shall forthwith refer the Schedule of the Senate Amendments to the relevant Committee for consideration pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 145 (*Senate amendments to Bills originating in the National Assembly*), and report such fact to the House on resumption;

AND WHEREAS, the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 2 of 2026) was published vide Kenya *Gazette* Supplement No. 14 of 19th February 2026 as a Bill to provide for the equitable division of revenue raised nationally among the national and county levels of government as required by Article 218 of the Constitution and was considered and passed by the National Assembly on 10th March 2026, and thereafter referred to the Senate for consideration in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(4) of the Constitution;

FURTHER WHEREAS, on 14th May 2026, the Senate considered and passed the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 2 of 2026) **with amendments** and, in accordance with the provisions of Article 112 of the Constitution, referred the Bill back to the National Assembly for reconsideration;


NOTING THAT, the Bill is critical in facilitating the proper functioning of the national and county governments, and the continuity of service delivery to the citizens, and given the applicable statutory timelines, the Bill has been determined to be a priority Bill;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **NOTIFIED** to all Members of the National Assembly and the general public—

- (1) **THAT**, the *Schedule of Senate Amendments* to the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 2 of 2026) now stand referred to the **Budget & Appropriations Committee** for consideration;
- (2) **THAT**, in view of the priority accorded to the Bill, the Committee is required to expedite the consideration of the amendments and submit its report upon resumption of the House;
- (3) **THAT**, upon resumption of the House, and to ensure adherence to the applicable statutory timelines, the House Business Committee shall expedite consideration of the *Senate Amendments* to the Bill; and

(4) THAT, the Clerk is directed to transmit this Notification and the *Schedule of Senate Amendments* to all Members of the National Assembly and facilitate consideration of the Senate Amendments to the Bill by the Committee.
